

Two injured and man charged following serious crash involving three vehicles on A1



Police are appealing for witnesses following a serious road traffic collision involving three vehicles that took place around 1350 hours on Saturday afternoon on the A1 at the junction with the A1087 (Cement Works).

A VW Transporter collided with a Vauxhall motor car and third Seat motor car was also involved.

Sergeant Andy Gibb said: "One lane of the southbound carriageway remained closed for over four hours to allow for collision investigation and recovery of the vehicles. Two females remain in hospital for treatment to serious injuries but are expected to make a full recovery. A 22 year old male involved in the collision has been charged with a driving offence and will be reported to the Procurator Fiscal."
