Marathonbet will donate £500 to the Hibs Community Foundation following Simon Murray's winning Edinburgh Derby goal celebration last night.

Hibernian's main club sponsor paid a visit to the training centre in September to give the striker a Goal Celebration Makeover – with the supporters voting 'Simon Says' as their favourite celebration.

Murray couldn't have chosen a bigger occasion as he picked up the ball from Brandon Barker in the 3rd minute, nutmegged Hearts' John Souttar, before lashing the ball home with a devastating strike and celebrating with the supporters' voted celebration – 'Simon Says'!

After the match, Murray said: "It doesn't get much better than that, under the lights on a Tuesday night! I certainly went nuts when the goal went in. I think that's £500 to charity which is great but obviously it's a goal I'll never forget."
