The hotel is housed in a Georgian townhouse and it includes an elegant wine bar, a cocktail lounge, library, function space and four individually designed rooms.

At the heart of the hotel is the wine library, claimed to be a place of entertainment, knowledge and community designed by architect Claudio Silvestrin.

Guests can experience the Cru wines from ZONIN1821's Estates offered by the glass in stylish surroundings with red marble from Verona, sleek lines and a warm wood.
