

Man due in court in connection with Tranent housebreakings



A 27-year-old man has been arrested and charged following two housebreakings in the Tranent area which took place in Kemp's End and Lawson Way between Monday, November 13, and Wednesday, November 15.

The 27-year-old will appear at Edinburgh Sheriff Court on Thursday, November 16.
