

Remembrance Service at Heart of Midlothian War Memorial



Sunday, 12th November, will see the annual Remembrance Service at the Heart of Midlothian War Memorial at Edinburgh's Haymarket.

Hearts club chaplain Andy Prime will conduct the service which will, as usual, be attended by Hearts players, coaching staff and board members. The service starts at 10.45am and will end around 11.20am.

Morrison Street will be closed from around 9.30am until 12 noon.
