

Muscat a step closer thanks to air link



Oman Air linking Scotland's Capital with Muscat

Edinburgh to Oman is now possible thanks to Oman Air and Flybe's new through fares.

They start from £450 and build on the success of Oman Air's double daily flights from London Heathrow and the daily flight from Manchester Airport.

Guests can also book the through fares from Aberdeen and Glasgow.
