

Scotland debut for Hibs' striker Abi Harrison



Hibernian Ladies striker Abi Harrison made her debut for the Scotland Women's National Team on Monday as the side drew 0-0 in a friendly match with Russia.

Harrison came on for the final 15 minutes of the match, alongside team-mates Kirsty Smith, Rachael Small and Rachel McLaughlan who all started the game, and Jenna Fife also came on as a substitute to pick up her second cap for the side.

The match completed the La Manga training camp for the national side, who were visited by Scotland legend Kenny Dalglish.. The side lost 3-0 on Friday to a strong Norway outfit.
