Community council meeting on Tuesday to discuss Meadowbank plans

Craigentinny Community Council will hold a meeting on Tuesday to discuss plans for the replacement of Meadowbank Stadium.

The campaign group <u>Save Meadowbank</u> say that there is little support for the current planning applications for the site which set out a smaller footprint for the replacement stadium and housing.



They claim that only 19.4% of comments on the council planning portal were supportive of the plans to change the use from open space to housing/commercial and that out of the 314 comments relating to the second application which aims to build a smaller sports centre only 27.1% were positive and in favour of the development.

Campaigner Linda Furley said : "Most people do not want the land sold for housing, especially when the number of sporting facilities is being significantly reduced.

"That was a view expressed repeatedly when Edinburgh Council last tried to downsize Meadowbank and remains the same now."
