

Witness appeal following one-vehicle collision on M90 south of Queensferry Crossing



Police are appealing for information after a serious road traffic collision on the M90 south of the Queensferry Crossing at junction 1A last night

The one vehicle collision happened at around 8:10pm on the southbound carriageway and involved a red BMW 3 series.

A 29-year-old man suffered serious injuries and was taken to Edinburgh Royal Infirmary for treatment.

Sergeant Scott Sneddon from the Dalkeith Trunk Roads Policing Group said: "Our investigations into the collision are ongoing and we are reviewing CCTV as well as speaking to a number of witnesses.

"There would have been a number of vehicles on the road at the time and we would urge anyone who hasn't spoken to us but saw the vehicle prior to the collision, or the incident itself to come forward.
