Radio Lollipop is an international charity founded 39 years ago. The service to children and young people is provided

entirely by volunteers who have been specially selected and trained to make a child's stay in hospital more fun and less frightening. Radio Lollipop volunteers spend time with each and every child on the wards at the Royal Hospital for Sick Children in Edinburgh, providing interactive play as live radio shows are simultaneously presented. The unique service has been available in Edinburgh since 1989 and continues to go from strength to strength.

The money raised at the event will secure the charity's future for another year and will bring many more smiles to the faces of the children in hospital.
