Diary of an Expat is a relevant and thought-provoking one-woman show, directed by Katharina Reinthaller (Labels, Fringe First Winner 2015), telling the comic story of the encounter between modern migrant Cecilia and London – a contemporary El Dorado craved by generations of young Europeans.



Based on real testimonies as well as personal experiences of writer Cecilia Gragnani, *Diary of an Expat* looks at lives of Europeans abroad and their urgency to understand and explore what expatriating means for a younger generation.

Confronting the legal technicalities of becoming a citizen of another country, Cecilia questions what role this will play on her identity and how we decide where we belong. *Underbelly*
