

Investigation underway after business premises in Dunbar targeted



Police are investigating after three premises were targeted by housebreakers in the Spott Road area of Dunbar.

Between 5pm on Friday 17th and 8am on Saturday 18th August, two businesses were broken into and a three-figure sum of cash was stolen from one property, with nothing appearing to have been stolen from the other.

Officers believe an attempted break-in at a third store in Spott Road is linked to these offences and inquiries are ongoing to identify those responsible.

Sergeant Scott Nicolson from Haddington Police Station said: "Given the proximity and time all of these incidents occurred, we believe the same individuals are responsible and we would

urge anyone who remembers seeing any suspicious activity around Spott Road on Friday evening or Saturday morning to contact police immediately.

“In addition, anyone with information that can help us identify the culprits should also come forward.”
