

Hearts Sign Sean Clare on Three Year Deal



Ladbroke's Premiership leaders Hearts have added to their already considerable squad by signing English midfield player Sean Clare on a three-year contract.

Clare's contract with English Championship side Sheffield Wednesday ended at the end of last season meaning the 21-year-old was a free agent. There was reputed interest from clubs in the English Premier League and Championship, but the attacking midfielder has opted to join Hearts and assist their challenge for silverware.

Hearts latest recruit – after what has been a busy summer – told the official club website:

"I'm buzzing to be here. I'm really happy to get it done and I'm looking forward to what's to come. There has been interest from England in the Premier League and the Championship."
