

Police name man who dies after being struck by tram



A man who died after being struck by a tram in Edinburgh yesterday has been named as Carlos Correa Palacio.

Carlos, who was 53, was sadly pronounced dead at the scene of the incident near to the Saughton Tram Stop off Broomhouse Drive which happened at around 12.15pm yesterday, Tuesday 11th September.

Officers from Edinburgh's Road Policing Unit are investigating the collision, Sergeant John Easton said: "My thoughts are with Carlos's family and friends and we are providing

specialist support to them, they have requested that their privacy is respected at this difficult time. This was a particularly upsetting incident for all those who witnessed it, both passengers on the tram and the driver. Officers spent considerable time yesterday both speaking to people at the scene and examining the tram, and we will continue to investigate to establish the circumstances.
