

# Witness appeal following verbal argument in Hope Park Terrace



Police are appealing for witnesses following an incident in the Meadows area which took place around 1.15am on this morning.

A member of the public reported hearing a man and a woman in the middle of a loud verbal argument within Hope Park Terrace and it is believed the pair then drove off in a 4x4 vehicle, which headed onto Causewayside.

Inquiries are ongoing to determine the full circumstances of this incident and anyone with information is asked to come forward.

The man involved in the argument is described as white, 5ft 8ins tall with a medium build and shaved or bald head. He was wearing a dark suit and was driving a silver or grey Range Rover Evoque.

Detective Inspector Clark Martin from Gayfield CID said: "There may be a perfectly innocent explanation as to what

happened here, however, we are keen to trace both individuals and speak with them about the matter.

“In addition, anyone who was in the area at the time and witnessed this incident take place, or who has any other information that can assist with this investigation should also contact police immediately.”
