

Hibs' Development squad run riot at Lesser Hampden



It's not just the Hibs' first team that are on a goal-scoring spree these days, the Development Squad also secured a six goal margin victory yesterday in the SPFL Reserve Cup at Lesser Hampden against Partick Thistle Reserves.

Five minutes later and Allan completed his hat-trick in fortunate style when the ball deflected off his heel then Murray also grabbed his third of the day to end a superb performance in Glasgow.
