

Man charged after assistant referee struck with coin at Tony Macaroni Arena



A 30-year-old man has been charged after an assistant referee was struck with a coin during the game between Livingston and Rangers at the Tony Macaroni Arena on Sunday 30th September.

He is scheduled to appear at Livingston Sheriff Court on Friday 5th October.

Superintendent Craig Smith, Event Commander for the match, said: "As a result of this incident we received an overwhelming number of calls from the public, who shared our position that such behaviour was totally unacceptable.
