Goalkeeper Ofir Marciano was delighted to be named in the first team squad for Hibs weekend's 6-0 victory over Hamilton Academical at Easter Road Stadium.

The Israeli international has achieved one of the targets he set for himself after undergoing surgery on his finger injury and will not relax now that he has been involved with the first team once again.

Marciano told Hibernian Media: "It was great to be back involved. When you set yourself a target and you get it, it is a very good feeling and I am happy.

"I won't rest now. I need to move forward and chase all of my other targets.
