SGB Championship play-off, semi-final, second-leg: Workington Comets 52, Glasgow Tigers 38 (agg: 90-89)

Edinburgh Monarchs star Ricky Wells won the 30th and final heat in the SGB Championship play-off, semi-final to take his tally for the night to 13 points.

Ex-Workington Comets star Wells, standing in for Glasgow Tigers' crooked No 1 Craig Cook, powered to the flag from the gate on his former track.
