Witness appeal following armed robbery at Livingston bookmaker



Police are appealing for witnesses following an armed robbery at a bookmakers which took place around 9.25pm on Thursday evening at the Ladbrokes premises on Hawk Brae in Livingston.

The male suspect entered the premises and threatened the staff member with a knife. He then made off with a three-figure sum of cash.

The suspect is described as a white man, aged in his thirties, of slim build and around 6ft tall. He had dark facial hair with a black scarf or snood partially covering his face and was wearing a dark coloured jacket.

Officers are now investigating and anyone who can help with ongoing inquiries is asked to come forward.

Detective Inspector Paul Batten from Livingston CID said: "This was a frightening experience for the staff member who was thankfully uninjured as a result of the incident.

"We believe the suspect was on foot and I would ask anyone who was in the Hawk Brae area at around 9.25pm last night, and who may have seen him, to come forward and contact officers. "We are conducting a number of lines of inquiry to trace the man responsible and would ask anyone with any information to assist our inquiries, to get in touch immediately."
