
Granton Waterfront — drop in event on Thursday afternoon

The City of Edinburgh Council have appointed Collective Architecture to consider the opportunities for Granton Waterfront. They want to develop a new vision for the area in a masterplan which will be devised by March 2019. The planning committee will then approve it as planning guidance only.

There are information stations where you can take a look at more details of the project at the North West Locality office, West Pilton Neighbourhood Centre, Muirhouse Library, Pennywell All Care Centre, Edinburgh College, Royston/Wardieburn Community Centre, Granton Library and Madelvic House.

In 2007 city architects Allan Murray devised a masterplan for the gasometer which forms a part of the area. <u>You can read</u> more about their ideas here.
