

Kylie is staying in Edinburgh for one more night!

The promoters of the Kylie concert next July have announced today that due to phenomenal demand, they have added a second night. Tickets went on sale today Friday 16 November at 9am and within 15 minutes were sold out, making this one the fastest selling Castle concert ever.
