

Use your contactless card on LothianCountry from Saturday

Customers travelling on Lothiancountry's West Lothian services will be able to pay for their fare using contactless from this Saturday 1 December 2018.

The technology has been fitted to Lothiancountry's West Lothian vehicles providing customers with a quick and convenient payment option. VISA or Mastercard payment cards will be accepted, as well as Apple Pay and Google Pay.

Across this weekend the company will also be introducing Service X18 between Edinburgh and Armadale and a new weekend night service N28 between the Omni Centre, Edinburgh and Livingston.

Nigel Serafini, Commercial Director from Lothian said: "This is the first time that we will be offering contactless payment for journeys on our services between Edinburgh and West Lothian.
