

Investigation ongoing following break ins at business premises in Livingston

Police are appealing for witnesses following a break-in at two business premises in Dedridge, Livingston.



The incident happened between 8pm on Thursday 13 December and 8.30am on Friday 14 December in the Douglas Rise area of the town.

Entry was forced into two premises. A four figure sum of cash and products worth a four figure sum were taken from one and a three figure sum of cash from the other.

Detective Constable Tony Gilhooley of Livingston CID said: "These kind of break-ins can cause a huge strain on businesses and we are seeking witnesses and information which could help us trace those responsible.

"We are treating these break-ins as linked and would like to speak to anyone who may have seen something suspicious overnight between Thursday 13 and Friday 14 December.
