

Contractor appointed in new marina development

Edinburgh Marina Holdings, the developer behind Edinburgh Marina appointed McLaughlin & Harvey as the main contractor for the first phase of the new development at Edinburgh's waterfront.

Phase one of the development is a new 373 berth Edinburgh Marina with 24/7 access to the sea at all tides along with a new 187 bedroom Hyatt Regency Spa & Conference Hotel with 98 serviced apartments, the luxury Royal Wharf Living for Retirement residential scheme and three residential apartment blocks of 338 apartments.
