Hibs' youngsters Oli Shaw and Sean Mackie have won call-ups to the Scotland Under-21 squad for their forthcoming friendlies against Mexico and Sweden.

The squad will base themselves in Marbella, Spain for the double-header with Mexico (22 March) and Sweden (25 March).

Scott Gemmill's side have been drawn against Croatia, Czech Republic, Greece, Lithuania and San Marino.

The nine group winners will qualify automatically for the finals, while the runners-up with the best records against the teams coming first, third, fourth and fifth in their group will go into a play-off in a bid to reach the tournament cohosted by Hungary and Slovenia.

The qualifiers kick off in September with the visit of San Marino and a trip to Croatia.

"Obviously Oli's been involved through the age levels and it's always been an ambition of mine to follow in his footsteps.
