Planning permission granted for housing at Shawfair

Housebuilders Mactaggart & Mickel have received planning permission to build the next phase of their flagship Millerhill housing development at Shawfair in Midlothian. Mactaggart & Mickel are currently on site, finalising the first phase of the development which comprises a total of 137 private homes and 32 affordable homes and is due to be completed at the end of the year.
