

Police hunt youths after three cyclists pushed into Union Canal



Police are appealing for witnesses following attacks on cyclists at the Union Canal.

Between 5pm and 9.15pm three men were cycling on the path near Murrayburn and Wester Hailes when they were confronted by a group of youths.

On each occasion, the cyclists were pushed into the canal and sustained minor injuries.

Inquiries are ongoing to trace those responsible and anyone with information is asked to come forward.

Sergeant Alex Dickson from the South West Community Policing Team said: "The youths may have thought this was a bit of fun, but it could have resulted in serious injury, or worse, and we

are treating these incidents very seriously.

“In response, we are going to deploy high-visibility patrols in the area to engage with cyclists and members of the public and deter any further incidents.

“If you witnessed anything suspicious on the Union Canal cycle path on Wednesday evening, or if you believe you can provide us with a description of the suspects, then please contact police immediately.

“In addition, we are also eager to hear from anyone else with any other information relevant to this investigation.”
