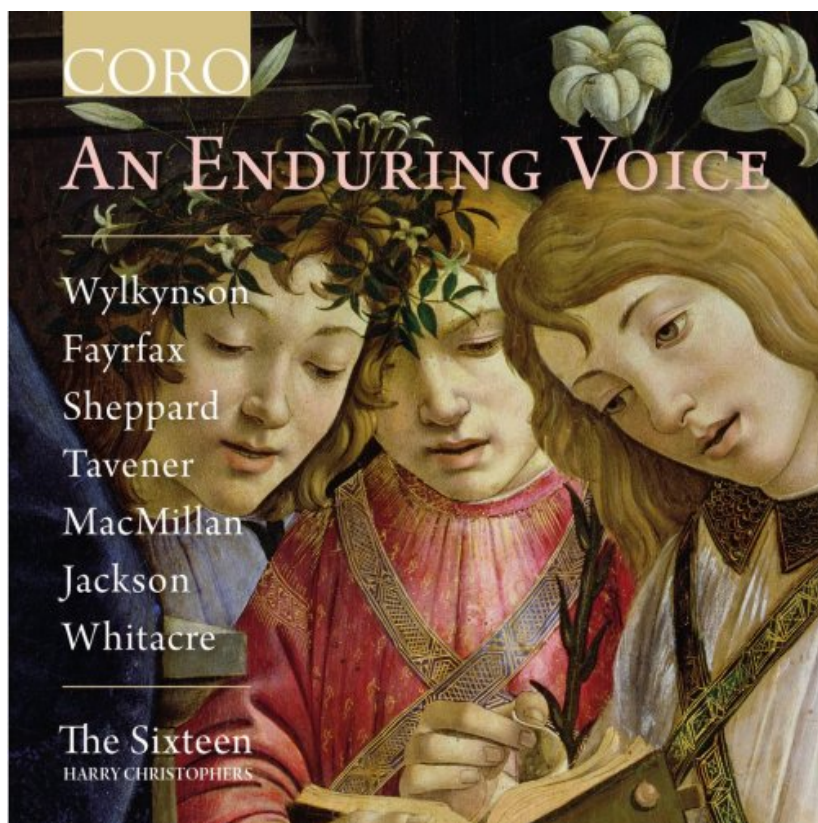


The Sixteen will perform at Greyfriars Kirk in October on their annual choral pilgrimage
