The academic strand is curated by David Bishop, programme leader for Creative Writing at Edinburgh Napier University, and the author of 20 novels. Audiences will hear mini presentations covering the latest academic research, presented in a dynamic, accessible manner.

Festival founder and director Ann Landmann said :"We've been overwhelmed by the enthusiastic and incredibly supportive responses from publishers and authors, and the interest this has sparked around the world. It was difficult limiting the programme to the 80 speakers now appearing at the festival.
