Love Music's Artistic Director Stephen Deazley will run the full marathon, the Chair of the Board of Trustees, Neil Weir, and Love Music's Manager & Producer, Ruth Davie, will run the half marathon, and Events Assistant, Kirsten Hunter, the 10K.
