Comfortably sleeping four, with two children in the cosy upstairs sleeping loft, and two adults downstairs in the convertible living space, this unique architectural gem, could easily be utilised as extra accommodation for any family in the domestic marketplace, or as a studio.

The main living space downstairs comprises of a kitchenette with two burner induction hob, LED track lighting, fridge and sink; together with a full bathroom with shower, basin, and a specialist, high specification, composting toilet which requires no sewage connection.

With part of the downstairs living space as yet unfurnished, the opportunity exists for any buyer to put their own unique

stamp on this property. They can opt for the planned seating area with removeable table which easily converts to a double bed, or install their own free standing furniture in the space, in which case the NestPod, available to collect from Tiny House Scotland's base in Linlithgow, can be purchased for £38,900.

Tiny House Scotland can also work with the buyer to carry out further customisation to suit their needs, if required.

With all utilities – electricity, water and propane – “plug and play”, just like a mobile home, the NestPod is fully self contained and mobile, being of legal towable size for UK roads. Complete with its own specialist trailer on which it sits, it could form a magnificent centrepiece to any self catering development looking to stand out from the crowd.
