

Tommy Block joins Queen's Park on season long loan



Hibs' Development Squad midfielder Tommy Block has agreed a season-long loan move to Queen's Park.

The 19-year-old will benefit from regular first-team football in a competitive environment, while still being able to work on his game through the week at the Hibernian Training Centre under the watchful eye of Hibs' specialist staff.

He will also be able to take part in the Development Squad's specially arranged games programme against handpicked opposition, following the club's decision to withdraw from the Reserve League.

Block told Hibs' Media: "This is a great opportunity for me and I want to make the most of it."
