"I'm quite direct. I like to go into one v one situations and I can give the team breathers when we are struggling and get us up the pitch.

"I am quite composed on the ball too so I'll look to bring that into the game. I'll also look to try and score goals and help the team.

"It's crazy! I played there (Ibrox)when I played for Hibs and the atmosphere is overwhelming and gives you shivers every single week.
