On 19 September at Prestonfield House there is an invitation only event when all of the lifesize sculptures and four of the mini ones will be up for auction. The aim of the Oor Wullie Bucket Trail has always been to raise vital funds for children and young people in hospital across Scotland.

If you are not at the event then you will be able to place a bid by [registering online](#). The event will be streamed live online. Bidding is expected to start between £4000 and £5000 per large sculpture.

All proceeds will go to Edinburgh Children's Hospital Charity (EHC) to fund vital medical equipment and research, family
