Heroin and stun gun seized during police raid



A man and a woman have been charged after £18,000 worth of heroin and a stun gun was seized after officers executed two warrants in

Saughton Mains Terrace on Thursday.

A 34-year-old man and a 39-year-old woman were arrested and charged in connection with the incident and were due to appear at Edinburgh

A Police Scotland spokesperson said: "Local officers executed two warrants in Saughton Mains Terrace yesterday.

"Heroin, with maximum street value of £18,000, was seized. What appeared to be a stun gun, or similar device, was also recovered during the search.
