

Witness appeal after man dies following fatal collision in Leith



Police are appealing for witnesses following a fatal collision which happened around 1.10pm on Tuesday 3rd September at Newkirkgate.

Enquiries are continuing to establish the full circumstances, however, it appears a Vauxhall Astra car and an HGV have been involved and as a result a 62-year-old male pedestrian sustained serious injuries.

Emergency services responded to the scene and sadly the man was pronounced dead.

Anyone with information is asked to come forward.

Inspector Roger Park from the Road Policing Unit in Edinburgh said: "Our deepest sympathies are with the family of the

pedestrian killed during this incident and we are working to establish exactly what has happened.

“Members of the public who were nearby at the time and saw what happened, or who may have any relevant dash-cam footage should contact police immediately.

“Likewise, anyone with any other information that can assist our ongoing enquiries is also urged to get in touch.”
