The Edinburgh Worldwide Photo Walk event will start from Calton Hill at 10:00am on 5 October 2019. The route will cross the city, finishing in the Grassmarket around 1:00pm. It's totally free to attend the Photo Walk but places are limited to 50 photographers who need to register here.
