

Work begins on water main upgrade in Winchburgh

Morrison Construction have just begun work on a £1m water main upgrade for Winchburgh.

The idea is to future proof the existing system by increasing capacity fourfold.

The civil engineering project for Winchburgh Developments, designed by Sweco, involves replacing existing water mains down Faucheldean Road and Glendevon Track along with associated resurfacing works.

The project team from Morrison Construction's Water Scotland business established the building site in September, placing diversions around it.

The construction programme for the water mains upgrade is due to be completed in early 2020.

Morrison Construction Water Scotland Regional Director, Stephen Slessor said: "We look forward to continuing the successful working relationship with our client Winchburgh Developments and designer Sweco to successfully deliver this essential project for the local community.
