Hibernian Ladies' Jamie-Lee Napier has been named Scottish Building Society SWPL Player of the Month for October.

Napier has been in sensational form for Grant Scott's high-flying side, who clinched second spot in the league with Sunday's win over Forfar Farmington.

The award comes as a timely boost ahead of Sunday's SSE Scottish Women's Cup Final against Glasgow City at Tynecastle Park.
