

Early Christmas present for Grassmarket Community Project

Hub South East, Development Partner to public sector bodies in Edinburgh, the Lothians and Borders, this week presented an early Christmas present to the Grassmarket Community Project, handing over £20,000 after a Charity Golf Day held earlier this year.
