

Two men charged with Bristo Square break-in



Two men have been charged in connection with a theft from a static cabin premises on Bristo Square which took place around 6.50am on new-year's day.

A safe containing a five-figure sum of cash was stolen and on Friday a search of two properties in the Holyrood area resulted in the arrest of two men in connection with the theft. A quantity of heroin with a street value of £7,000 was also recovered during the operation.

A 50-year-old man and a 26-year-old man have been charged and will appear at Edinburgh Sheriff Court on Monday.

Detective Inspector Jon Pleasance from Edinburgh CID said:
"We are grateful for the all the support we have received from the public in relation to this investigation.
