

Family holiday ideas – discounted fares available to Orkney and Shetland

If you are already thinking ahead to summer or October then you should know about the Loganair sale which offers 3,000 free children's flights.

There are now larger aircraft on the route between Orkney and Edinburgh and the discounted offer applies to families travelling during the school holiday periods this summer on these routes.

You can get up to two tax-only tickets for children under 12 who travel with a full paying adult from today until all seats are sold.
