Union Canal breach plugged and fish saved

Scottish Canals confirm that they have secured the area and stopped the flow of water following a breach of the Union Canal near the A801 between Polmont and Muiravonside.

The breach followed last week's severe weather and Dr Olivia Lassiere, their environment manager, admitted this was a challenging task.

The Forth Rivers Trust have also rescued over 1,000 fish including pike, perch, roach, eel and brown trout from pools of water downstream of the breach.

She added: "We'd like to take this opportunity to remind canal users to be safe and to protect our staff by keeping physically distanced while we respond to this situation.
