

# SAY Award – Judges announced to pick Shortlist

**Today the Scottish Album of the Year Award judges were announced.**

They will now pick the Shortlist of 10 albums and the winner of the [Scottish Album of the Year Award](#). The Shortlist will be announced on 8 October 2020. The public vote will open on 5 October 2020 and music fans are invited to have their SAY during a 72 hour vote. The online vote is free and allows one vote per person. The Longlisted album with the most public votes secures a place on the shortlist and a minimum price of £1,000.

The 2020 Judging Panel, chaired by **John Williamson**, includes **Ally McCrae** (Producer, BBC), **Charlotte Dryden** (CEO, NI Music Prize), **Dirk Löwenberg** (Head of Member Services, GVL), **Edith Bowman** (Broadcaster), **Fay Milton** (Founder of SAY Award charity partner, Music Declares Emergency), **Jack Saunders** (Presenter, BBC Radio 1), **Jess Brough** (Founder/Director, Fringe of Colour), **Kieran Hurley** (Playwright), **Maurits Westerik** (Director, Best Kept Secret Festival), **Solène Lorry** (Head of Label & Artist Relations (France), YouTube), **Wezi Mhura** (Creative Producer & Founder of AfriFest & BLM Mural Trail).

The main prize of Scottish Album of the Year wins £20,000 for their achievement and that will be announced on 29 October 2020. There were originally 362 submissions entered for the [SAY Award](#) and these have already been whittled down to 20.
