

# Former Hibs' star named SWPL Player of the Month for November

Former Hibs' midfielder Lisa Robertson has been voted as the winner of the Scottish Building Society SWPL Player of the Month for November 2020.

Lisa played every minute for Celtic last month as they picked up maximum points from four games. This included a 1-0 win over Rangers and a 6-2 hammering of Hibs at Ainslie Park.





She scored a goal of the season contender in their victory over Hibs and played a vital role in the middle of the park throughout November as her side bounced back from defeat to Glasgow City on the opening day of the season.
