

# 15-year-old boy reported to youth assessor after stones thrown at buses and taxi

A number of buses and a taxi were damaged in the south east of the city through reckless behaviour after stones were thrown at them on Monday night.

Officers have confirmed that a 15-year-old boy has been charged and will be reported to the youth assessor in connection with these incidents. The investigation into the activity remains ongoing.
