Investigation underway following 'shocking and unprovoked' attack on 67-year-old man

Police are appealing for information following a reported serious assault, which took place in the Forth Street area around 9.50pm on Monday, 7 June when a 67-year-old man was struck in the face and suffered serious injuries as a result.

The suspect is male, aged between 30 and 40, 5ft 6 with a stocky build and unshaven face. He was wearing a dark beanie hat, hooded humper, coat and baggy trousers.



Detective Constable Christina Yeoman, of Gayfield CID, said: "This appears to have been a shockingly unprovoked and random attack, which left the victim with multiple serious injuries.
