Also the return of Nathan Cassidy, who was the only in-venue performer to put a show on at the 2020 Edinburgh Fringe; the return of late night show 'Hate'n'live' to the Free Festival; late night staple 'Shaggers' back for one-night only; and regular showcases events 'Laughing Horse Pick of the Fringe', 'Comedy Queers' LGBTQI showcase, 'Joke Thieves'.
