Because of this, many believe that the first online casino was developed in 1996, by Interactive Gaming Council. Some of the games that were available to download was the slot game *Fantastic Sevens*; table games such as Blackjack, Cyber Stud Poker, Roulette, and Craps, as well as video Poker – *Jacks or Better*, and Keno.

The following year, there were over 200 online casinos on the world wide web. That same year, the world's annual revenue

from online gambling soared to \$1billion. Since then, the industry has continued to expand, and modern technology has enabled online casinos to become more accessible than ever before.

The present

In the modern day, there are a huge variety of games you can play at an online casino, most of which have state-of-the-art graphics, and animations that are sure to whisk you away right into the heart of the casino atmosphere.
